

Service Centre for Foreign Workers

The Labour Inspection Authority, the Police, the Tax Administration and the Directorate of Immigration have established several Service Centres for Foreign Workers in Norway. Both the employers and the employees can obtain information and initiate a fast-track handling of applications here.

Our staff speaks several languages.

The Service Centre has been established to serve:

- Citizens of the nordic countries
- EU/ EEA citizens
- People with qualifications as a skilled worker and specialists
- Family members and employees of the abovementioned groups of people

At the Service Centre you may:

- Submit application for residence permit (this concerns skilled personnel, specialists and their family members from countries outside EU/EEA)
- Complete the electronic registration (concerns EU/EEA citizens). Opening registration procedures must be carried out electronically on the application web portal: <https://selfservice.udi.no>
- Hand in notification of immigration to the Population Register or change your address inside the country
- Obtain information on rights and obligations as an employee in Norway
- Obtain information on identity cards for building and construction sites

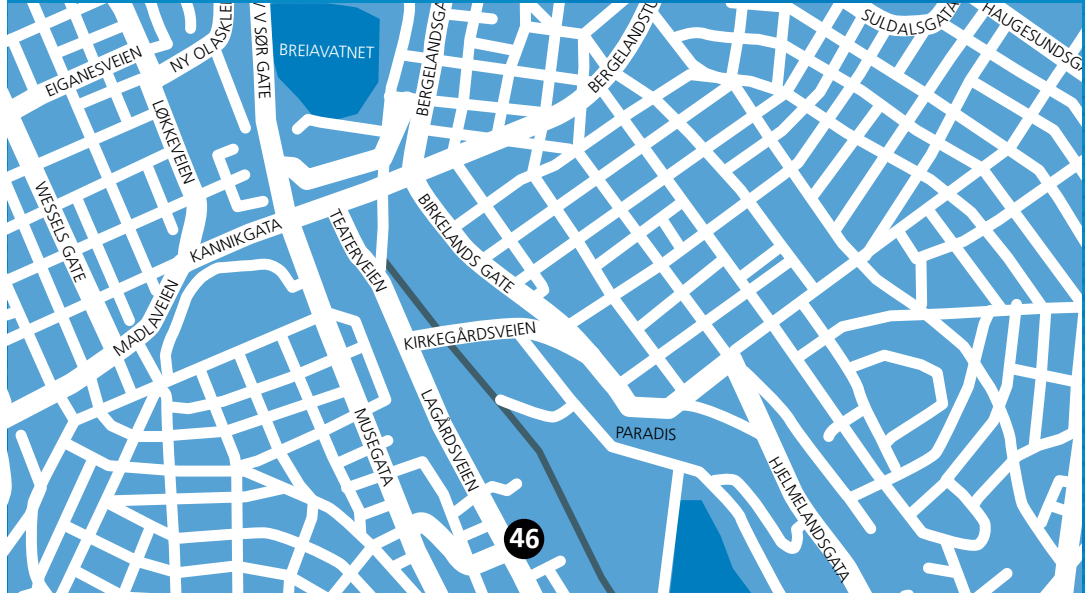
